Please submit your application by email containing:

- 1.** A cover sheet with your name, address, phone number, email, and your website if available.
- 2.** Ten digital images representing your work: you may need to send in more than one email.- images should be 1mg
- 3.** A page describing each image. Include the title of the artwork, media, date and dimensions. This could also be included on the digital image as the name.
- 4.** A current copy of your professional resume.
- 5.** A one-page letter of intent. This is a statement of your career goals, demonstrating your commitment to your art and describing your artistic need for the space.

IMPORTANT: Address the criteria listed below on one page only

- What your art means to you.
- Why you need this rental space.
- What are your goals as an artist?
- In what type of medium/media you will work.

- 6.** The names and telephone numbers of three local references who can be reached by phone. Include a current landlord, if renting, and some form of evidence of your previous one-year's residency in the Roaring Fork Valley.(e.g. utility statement)
- 7.** All materials submitted will become the property of the Red Brick Center for the Arts.
